The amendment passed. **The amended main motion was then passed.**

It was moved by Lion PDG James W. Rosburgh and seconded by Lion PCC Steve Wise that the district pay all the meals for those in attendance at this cabinet meeting. **Motion Passed.** Lion PDG Walter Hamer moved and Lion Nancy Eaves seconded that the policy be that all Club Presidents and

Club Secretaries would have their meals provided at the District 26M6 cabinet meetings. **Motion passed.**

Motion was made by Lion Jennie Mosher and seconded by Lion PDG James W. Rosbrugh that the \$100.00 fee for our mascot Merlin be paid from unbudgeted expenses. **Motion passed.**

Lion DG Peter Frantzen moved and Lion Elaine Crump seconded that the \$1,000 in the budget for the out-going District Governor to attend International Convention be carried over to next year for use by Lion DGE Craig Lehman to attend the International Convention in Hawaii. **Motion passed.**

At this point the **Tail Twister**, Lion Kent Wise proceeded to collect mandatory monetary mementos from malicious and misbehaving members.

When all business was done, the meeting was adjourned upon grand decree by the District Governor that all activities and business of this meeting of the district cabinet of 26-M6 were completed and he officially closed the last meeting as the District Governor.
